

# MariaDB Backup

## Commandes de base

### Informations

#### Backing Up a Single Database

```
mysqldump -u root -p database_name > database_name.sql
```

#### Backing up all databases

```
mysqldump -u root -p --all-databases > all-databases.sql
```

#### Append the date to te filename

```
mysqldump -u root -p database_name > database_name_$(date +%F_%H-%M).sql
```

## MariaDB backup in Docker

```
source .env && docker-compose exec mariadb mysqldump -uroot -p${MARIADB_ROOT_PASSWORD} --all-databases > mariadb-dump-$(date +%F_%H-%M-%S).sql
```
